YEAR 5 BIKEABILITY

The children in year 5 have received letters this week regarding Bikeability Cycle Training with Coventry City Council. Mrs Ellis is very keen that as many children as possible take advantage of this course so has agreed to fund the scheme from Sports Premium Funds.

The sessions start on **THURSDAY 28th MARCH 2018** for 6 weeks, until **THURSDAY 4th APRIL** during the school day. Children will need to

have good general control of their bike, their bike must be in a road worthy condition and a cycle helmet is compulsory (children that do not have the use of a bike can loan one from the school along with a helmet). If your child would like a place on the course, please complete the consent form attached to the letter and return to the school office by the deadline date of Monday 25th February so numbers can be confirmed with the trainers.
