Date of birth: August 5, 1930
Birth place: Wapakoneta, Ohio, U.S.
Date of death: August 25, 2012
He is known for astronaut, the first person to set foot on the Moon.
Kings Vase, Apollo 11 Congressional Space Medal of Honor (1969) Presidential Medal of Freedom (1969) his first airplane ride at age 6.
He became a licensed pilot on his 16th birthday and a naval air cadet in 1947.
In 1955 and immediately following his graduation from Purdue, Armstrong became an experimental research test pilot.
He applied at the National Advisory Committee for Aeronautics (NACA) and was selected in 1955. He was testing multiple planes. Armstrong joined the NASA in 1962.
On 20 July 1969, Apollo 11 became the first ship to land on the Moon.
