2. Why do we enjoy learning? We enjoy learning because ?
3. How do adults help us at Coundon Primary?
4. How do we care for each other?
5. What helps to make us feel safe?
6. What is good about the school behaviour systems in school?
7. How do we keep fit and healthy at school?
8. What opportunities do we have as children in school that help to make our school better? (Play pals, MVP etc.)
9. What would help to improve our school?

Teachers to help school councillors explain the judgements and do a tally chart with show of hands. Encourage children to be honest. *School councillors to do tally.*
