National Curriculum Objectives:

Differentiation:

**Beginner** 11 spellings split into blocks of 5 and six with separate word banks. Number of letters given. Aimed at Year 5 Emerging.

**Easy** 11 spellings split into blocks of 5 and six with separate word banks. Number of letters given. Words in the word banks have jumbled letters. Aimed at Year 5 Developing.

**Tricky** 11 spellings split into blocks of 5 and six with separate word banks. Number of letters given. Words in the word banks are synonyms of spellings. 1 or 2 letters given in each spelling as a clue. Aimed at Year 5 Secure/Year 6 Emerging.

**Expert** 11 spellings with one word bank. Number of letters given. Words in the word banks are synonyms of spellings. Aimed at Year 6 Developing.

**Brainbox** 11 spellings with one word bank. Words in the word banks are synonyms of spellings. Aimed at Year 6 Secure.

**Genius** 11 spellings without a word bank. Aimed at Year 6 Mastery.
